

Re-Opening of Muskegon Alano Club – May 4, 2020

After much discussion, the Board of the Muskegon Alano Club has decided to re-open on an appointment only basis. In attempting to comply with Governor Whitmer's Executive Order, meetings will be by appointment only by calling Russ Larson at 231-798-3961. Guidelines will be as follows:

1. Any dues paying member of the Muskegon Alano Club may reserve a one-hour time slot by calling Russ Larson at 231-798-3961. Invitees to that member's meeting do not have to be members.
2. Meetings can be reserved on the even hour any time from 8 am to 8pm for one hour (8am, 10am, noon, 2pm, 4pm, 6pm, and 8pm) – Sunday through Saturday.
3. The upstairs large meeting room and the lower large meeting room shall both be utilized although the club asks that no more than ten are in one room at one time.
4. The person reserving the meeting shall have the following duties:
 - A. Invite no more than nine others to join him or her;
 - B. Ensure that no one else is allowed into the building once the 10-person limit is reached in each room;
 - C. Making sure the group cleans and disinfects all table-tops, armchairs, and bathrooms after use;
 - D. Ensure that his or her group members wear masks while inside the building; and
 - E. Be responsible for following the NO FOOD rule. Only BYO beverages are allowed into the club. **ABSOLUTELY NO SHARED BEVERAGES.**

The Alano Board asks that room rent be taken by donation as usual and that those reserving the upstairs enter by the front door on Henry Street and those reserving the downstairs enter by the side ramp door. Any group found violating these rules shall prevent any member of that group from further reservation of rooms. The Alano Club shall review these guidelines on a weekly basis. God bless, one day at a time.
