- Open service positions:
 1. District Committee Member for South (Grand Haven, Ferrysburg & Spring Lake meetings) — Link between GSR (General Service Representative), groups, and area delegate; visit groups within zone to help with problems; contribute to growth and well-being of groups; attend Area Assemblies.
 2. Alternate District Committee Member North & South — Assist District Committee Member for zone.
 3. Public Information / Cooperation with the Professional Community Chair — PI - Provide accurate AA information to public & local media; visit schools or community groups; emphasizing anonymity & AA singleness of purpose // CPC - provide information to those who have contact with alcoholics through their Profession
 4. Alternate Telephone Service Chair — Assist Committee Chair with checking hotline messages and respond or contact someone to respond to calls; maintain and update phone contact list on recording.

Step 4 tells us to take a personal inventory.
